ORDINANCE NO. 2022-5
 GENERAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE
 CHAMPAIGN-URBANA MASS TRANSIT DISTRICT
 CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS
 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022
 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2023

WHEREAS, the current fiscal year of the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District Champaign County, Illinois, begins July 1, 2022 and ends on June 30, 2023, and the said District is required by law to adopt its Budget and Appropriation Ordinance prior to or in the first quarter of such fiscal year, and the Board of Trustees has adopted such Ordinance after due notice and public hearing as required by law on June 30, 2022, and

WHEREAS, said Budget and Appropriation Ordinance appropriated a total amount of money in the amount of Fifty-Three Million Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$53,428,000), all as detailed and set forth therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CHAMPAIGN-URBANA MASS TRANSIT DISTRICT, Champaign County, Illinois, that:

Section 1. For the following corporate purposes of the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District and in the stated amounts, to wit:

There is hereby levied in the aggregate, a general tax upon all taxable property within the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District, Champaign County, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for the year 2022 to be levied and assessed in the year 2023, the aggregate sum of Eleven Million Seven Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Six and No/100 Dollars (\$11,724,226), comprised as follows:

a. For general corporate purposes, the sum of Eight Million Two Hundred Forty-One Thousand One Hundred Fifty-One and No/100 Dollars (\$8,241,151).

b. There is further levied, in addition to all other taxes and exclusive of and in addition to the amount of taxes levied for general purposes, the amount of One Million Six Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,600,000) for the purpose of providing monies for the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District's contributions required for Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund contributions.

c. There is further levied, in addition to all other taxes levied for general purposes, the amount of One Million Twenty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,020,000) for the purpose of providing monies for the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District's contribution required for Social Security System contributions.

d. There is further levied, in addition to all other taxes levied for general purposes, the amount of One Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$100,000) for protection of the Champaign- Urbana Mass Transit District under the Worker's Compensation Act.

e. There is further levied, in addition to all other taxes levied for general purposes, the amount of Seven Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$700,000) for liability insurance, claims service and claims.

f. There is further levied, in addition to all other taxes levied for general purposes, the amount of Forty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$40,000) for unemployment insurance.


g. There is further levied, in addition to all other taxes levied for general purposes, the amount of Twenty-Three Thousand Seventy-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$23,075) for auditing.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.

Section 3. The Secretary of the Board of Trustees is directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk of Champaign County, Illinois.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "Ayes" and "Nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Board of Trustees of the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District, at a duly called regular meeting of the said Board of Trustees on the 7th day of December, 2022.



II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2021 were \$10,007,891.

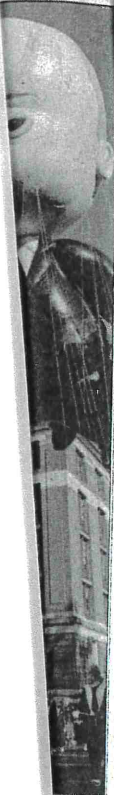
The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$11,724,226. This represents a 17.15% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2021 were \$0.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2022 are \$0. This represents a 0% increase over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2021 were \$10,007,891.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$11,724,226. This represents a 17.15% increase over the previous year.
