Minutes

1. Call to Order

Vice-Chair Nudo called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

5. Approval of Minutes

A. Board Meeting (Open Session) – April 29, 2026

MOTION by Mr. Fiscella to approve the open session minutes of the April 29, 2026, MTD Board meeting as distributed; seconded by Mr. Brown. Upon vote, the MOTION CARRIED.

7. Reports

A. Managing Director

Mr. Gnadt reviewed statistics for April 2026. April 2026 ridership was up 4.20% compared to April 2025. Mr. Gnadt noted that April 2026 and April 2025 had the same number of school days, weekdays, and weekend days, which offers a pure year-over-year comparison. Year-to-date ridership for FY2026 was up 4.07% compared to FY2025.

April 2026 operating revenue was 6.3% below April 2025. Year-to-date operating revenue was 0.40% below FY2025. Mr. Gnadt noted the predominate reason for the decrease in revenue is due to the reduction in interest revenue. Monthly operating expenses were up 10.7% from FY2025. Mr. Gnadt noted the predominate reason for this increase is due to the dramatic increase in fuel prices from last April. Mr. Gnadt noted that MTD purposefully budgets for fuel fluctuation to accommodate market variations. Year-to-date operating expenses were up 3.90% from FY2025. April 2026 operating revenue was \$1,613,704 above budget and operating expenses were \$3,573,338 below budget.

Mr. Gnadt shared that *Travel and Leisure Magazine* published an article titled *9 U. S. Cities With the Best Public Transportation – Besides New York City*, listing Champaign-Urbana, IL as number two. The article

1 noted that “Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District is an excellent example of how small cities can offer
2 high-quality transit”.

3 Mr. Nudo pointed out that ridership to Marketplace Mall has drastically decreased with their decision to
4 deny transit access to their property.

5 **B. FY2027 Draft Budget**

6 Mr. Gnadt noted the budget is a plan for the year ahead and accounts for both expected and anticipated
7 items. Notable impacts to the FY2027 budget are the anticipated 17 Cherry route, insurance rate increases,
8 and software implementation processes. The tentative budget has been available for public review on
9 MTD’s website since May 22, 2026. The public hearing on the FY2027 budget will be held at the next Board
10 meeting on June 24, 2026.

11 **8. Action Items**

12 **A. City of Urbana Letter of Support – Enterprise Zone Technical**
13 **Correction**

14 Mr. Gnadt was joined by Michelle Wright, Finance Director, and noted the City of Urbana currently abates
15 property taxes for five years on newly constructed homes with the existing program ending in FY2027.
16 Amending the abatement would allow homes built in FY2027 to receive the full five-year benefit. Ms.
17 Wright noted the Enterprise Zone is set to expire in 2030 and the City plans to apply for a ten-year
18 extension. Ms. Wright stated MTD has been asked to amend its resolution so abatements may continue for
19 the duration of the program rather than ending with the Enterprise Zone expiration, and to provide a letter
20 of support for a technical correction to be submitted to the State.

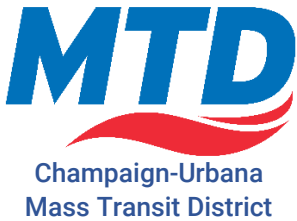

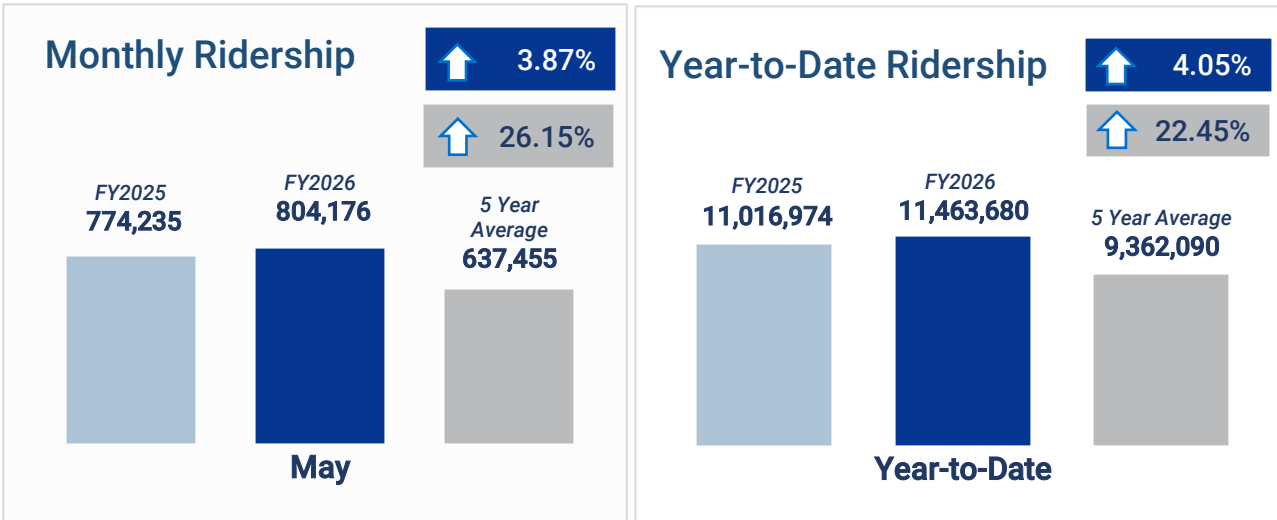

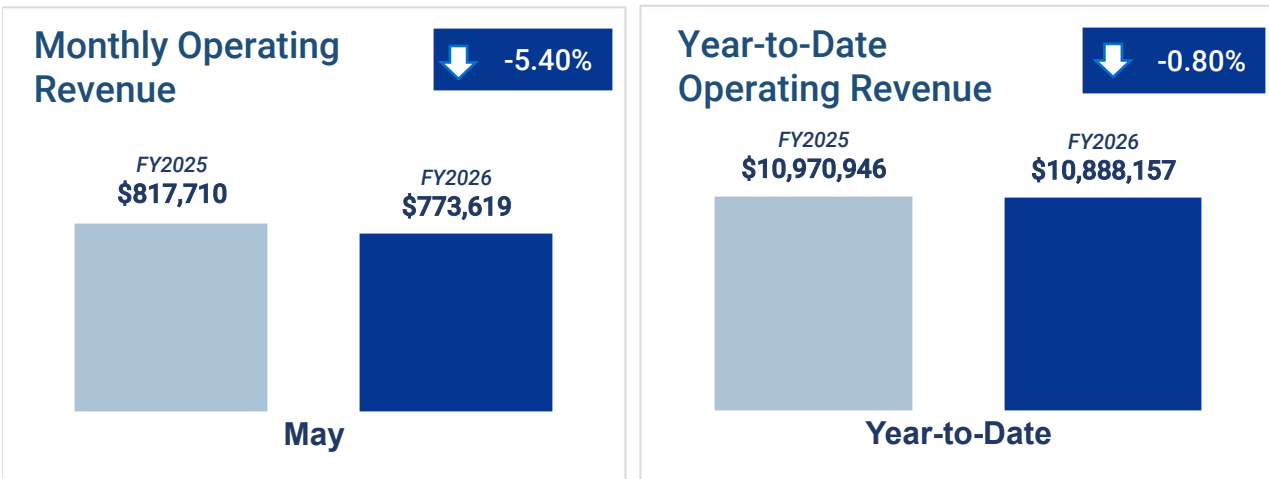

RIDERSHIP



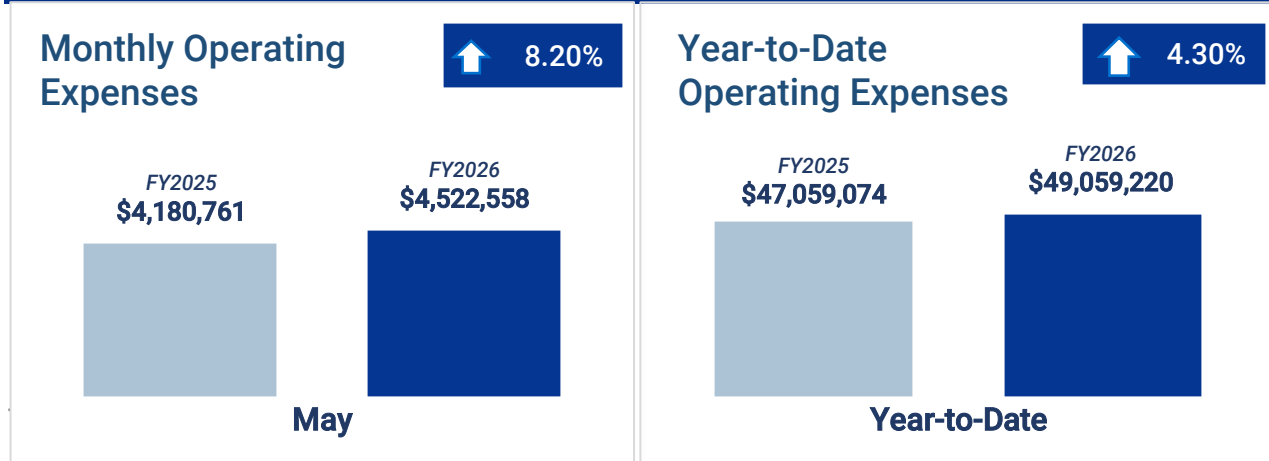
In May 2026, total ridership reached 804,176, up 3.9% from May 2025. Fiscal year-to-date ridership reached 11,463,680, a 4.1% increase from the same point last year. May had one fewer weekday, one fewer UI weekday, one fewer Urbana school day, and two fewer Champaign school days. The rest of the day types remained the same. May was colder and drier than last year, with an average temperature of 57.2 degrees and 0.67 inches of total precipitation. The average gas price was also much higher, at \$4.82 compared with \$3.28 last year.

OPERATING REVENUE



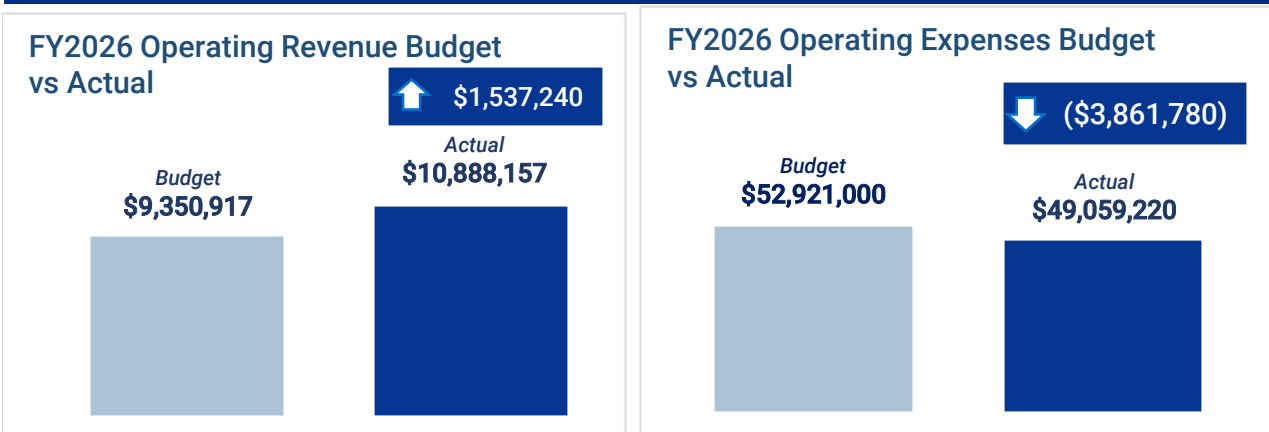
May 2026 operating revenue was 5.40% below May 2025. Year-to-date operating revenue was 0.80% below FY2025.

OPERATING EXPENSES



May 2026 operating expenses were 8.20% above May 2025. Year-to-date operating expenses were 4.30% above FY2025.

YEAR-TO-DATE REVENUE & EXPENSES



Year-to-date operating revenues were \$1,537,240 above budget while operating expenses were \$3,861,780 below budget.

MANAGING DIRECTOR'S NOTES

- 1) Our Operations Department continues to explore additional ways to better assist passengers and community members experiencing mental health crises. On May 29, Assistant Operations Director Randy Fouts attended an open house at the Rosecrance Behavioral Health Urgent Care Center, a newly established emergency care facility described as “central Illinois’ front door to immediate behavioral health support.”

For Operations, the Rosecrance Behavioral Health Urgent Care Center represents a vital new resource – a dedicated location where individuals experiencing a mental health crisis may be transported to receive immediate and potentially life-changing services. The center operates as a drop-off facility; if an individual is willing to go, they may be transported to the center and will receive services upon arrival. At this time, the facility is open Monday through Friday from 8 am to 5 pm, with plans to extend operating hours in the future.

The open house included a ribbon-cutting ceremony attended by Illinois Senator Dick Durbin, along with other dignitaries and community partners. The event provided an opportunity for partner organizations to learn more about Rosecrance’s approach, which includes rapid triage, comprehensive assessments, and crisis stabilization services designed to expand access to timely, compassionate care.

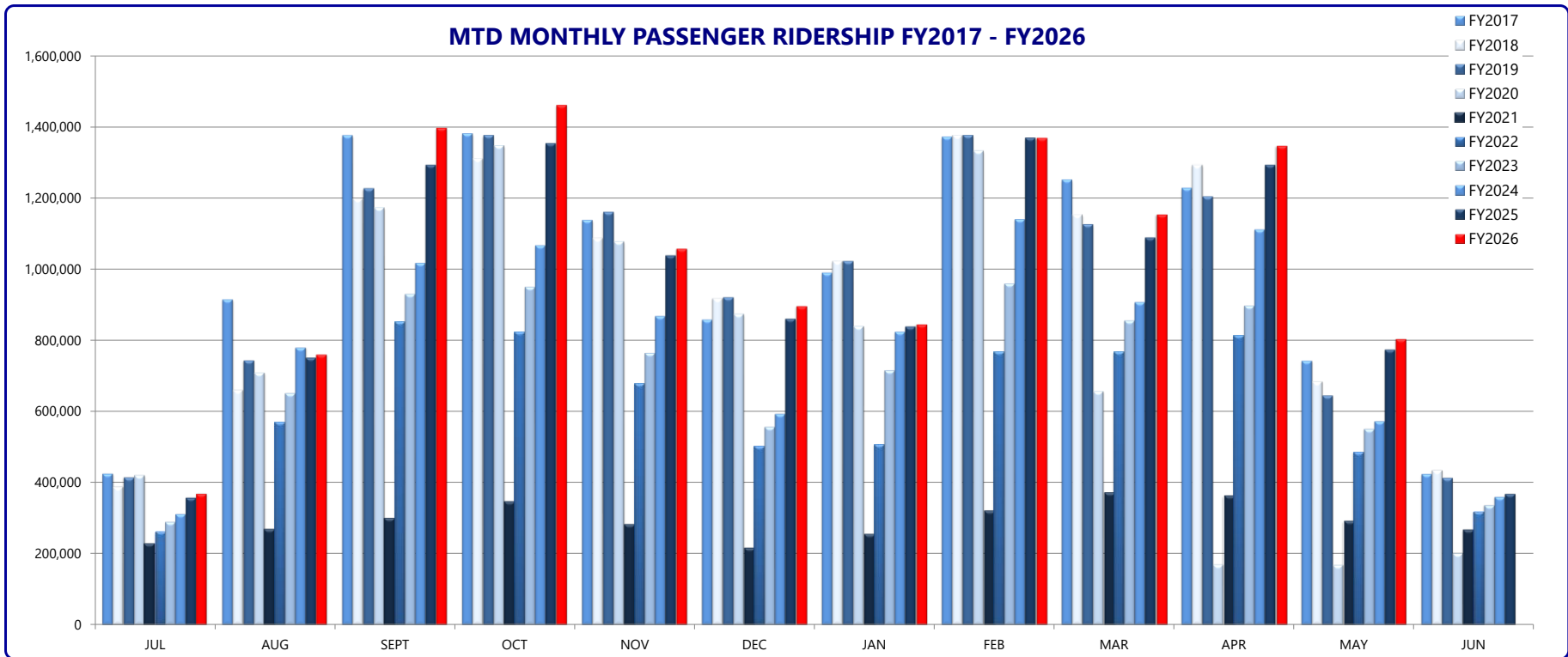
The gathering also allowed MTD to reaffirm its commitment to serving as a safe haven and to genuinely support the community through strong partnerships. During the event, MTD was able to remind partner agencies of existing transportation arrangements to access community services via our Supervisor vans. Individuals in need of services may be transported by Supervisors when one is available, provided a staff member from the requesting organization accompanies the individual.

A Social Worker from the University of Illinois Police Department REACH Program relayed her experiences in requesting assistance transporting someone to Rosecrance who preferred not to use a squad car. MTD may be contacted, and if a Supervisor is available and staffing permits, transportation can be provided.

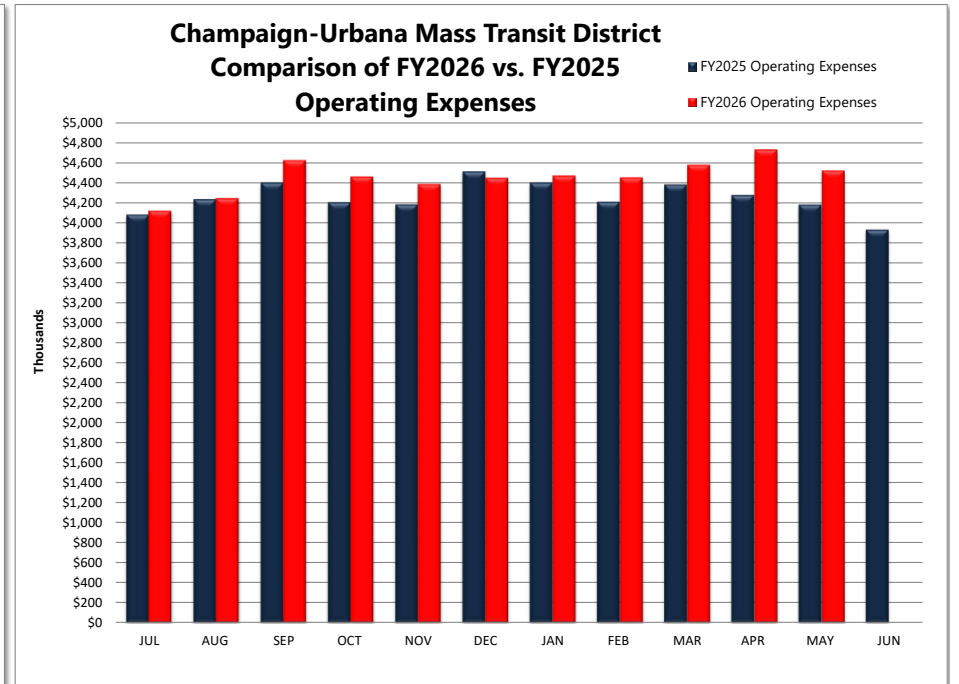
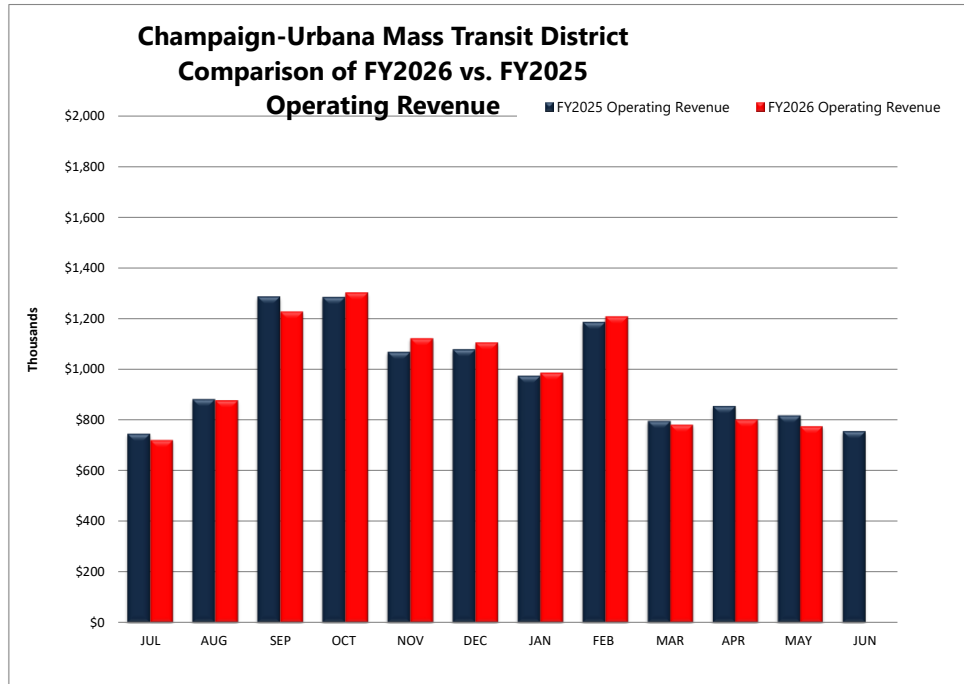

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY

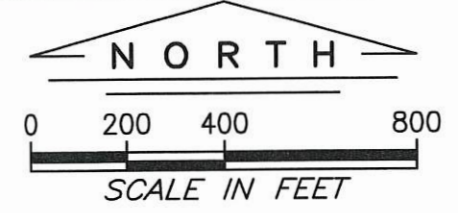
